Why SEECAT?



Sharp Increase in Anti-Terrorism Needs in Japan

Experiencing the terrorist incident regarding the murder of Japanese, a meeting of the Headquarters for Promotion of Measures Against Transnational Organized Crime and Other Relative Issues and International Terrorism was held by Japan's Government. The statement of this meeting mentioned their further efforts for collecting information and enhancing analytical capabilities as measures to prevent acts of terror before they occur, and conducting thorough measures at Japan's borders. Also, a review team on the safety of Japanese nationals was set up in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in February. Some more promotions of measures for security enhancement at critical infrastractures such as airports and public transportation started.

Last year, security measures offered for 2020 Tokyo Olympic & Paralympic Games attracted SEECAT visitors. However, after the number of terrorist incidents in 2014, more specific solutions such as high-end surveillance cameras and recognition systems are needed to enhance network and measures.

Hacking of SONY pictures made the serious threat of cyber attack on individuals, businesses and even nations clear. Interests of SEECAT visitors in measures for such attcks are higher than ever.





ONLY Exhibition for Anti-Terrorism in Japan

SEECAT, only exhibition in Japan focusing on counter-terrorism, has been gaining increasing attention from Japan's and foreign governments and anti-terrorism professtionals with urgent needs. Both hard and soft high-quality exhibits for counter terrorism annually gather at SEECAT.

SEECAT welcomed exhibitors from seven different countries and region last year. Trough eight times of holding the show, SEECAT has been becoming bigger and more international every year.



CLOSED SHOW Only for Professionals

SEECAT is a "closed show" that limits its admission only to law-enforcement, government, municipalities and professionals. It also welcomes many VIP guests such as the ambassadors from foreign embassies and executives from foreign police, intelligence agencies and interior ministries. These professionals highly evaluate SEECAT as a place for effective netwoking.

This "closed show" policy remains this year. On the other hand, promotions to invite more visitors from critical infrastructure including communications, hospitals and important private sectors such as security companies will be continued as well.






5) Cancellation
