



- Considering that this year's RISCON was held amid the COVID-19 pandemic, both visitors and exhibitors were required to register beforehand, and contact-free entry and exit checks using QR Codes were introduced. Thorough infection control measures, including requesting all attendees to take their temperature, wear masks, and disinfect their hands, were implemented under the guidelines of the state, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, and the venue.




- The ratio of visitors from "Manufacture" and "Government/Municipal Office," which are RISCON's core attendees, increased further than 2019.




## < Breakdown by Job >



### Q1 What is your job title?




### Q2 Level of Involvement in purchase decision




### Q3 How did you know RISCON TOKYO 2020? (Multiple answers)




### Q4 What is your purpose of visiting?






**Q1** The reason decide to exhibit at RICON (Multiple answers)









■ Although the overall number of visitors decreased at this year's exhibition by the COVID-19, about 80% to over 90% of exhibitors responded that the outcomes were "more than expected or as good as." Many said that they were able to promote the exhibition to purpose-driven visitors. RICON, which is now in its 16th year as an exhibition of risk control, attracts core repeat attendees from both the public and private sectors involved in risk control, indicating the high potential to match their needs.





**Q1** Level of Involvement in purchase decision




**Q2** How did you Know SEECAT'20? (Multiple answers)




## Infection Control
