#### **◆Booth**

#### 1) Basic Booth


As shown on the right, back and side panels

and booth number plate are going to be provided. \*Carpet is going to be provided for all booths (The color is selectable)

\*Panels are not going to be provided for island booths. \*Panels are not going to be provided on aisle-sides for corner booths

#### 2) Lavout Type

- 3 types are available
- Single-row
- Double-row (Available for 4 booths or more) •Island (Available for 12 booths or more)



#### 3) Booth Allocation

The organizer decides booth allocation taking exhibits, booth size, demonstration plans, dates of application, etc. into consideration.

#### 1) ①Application on Official Website:

No need to submit the original copy of your signed and sealed application form. You can complete the whole process from application to contract execution on the exhibition's official website. Please see the website for further information. \*The e-mail address of the person who approves your participation as an exhibitor is required besides the contact

## 2 Submit your application form (see attached document).

Fill in, sign, and seal the application form, and send it to the SEECAT Management Office. (The original copy is only acceptable.)

## 3) Withholding & Revocation

In case the organizer judges the exhibit is unsuitable for this exhibition it may withhold or revoke the application.

#### 1) Exhibit Space Fee

### 2) Included in Exhibit Space Fee

- Exposure through exhibitors list on official website and handouts
- Safety management and security guard fees by the organizer

#### 3) NOT Included in Exhibit Space Fee



# What is SEECAT?


### The Sole Exhibition Dedicated to Counter-Terrorism Measures in Japan! A Closed Show Limited to Qualified Visitors






